



## Summary of Expertise, Experience, and Affiliations and Interests

### Chemicals Management Plan Science Committee

#### Purpose

Table 1: Summary of Responses summarizes the information about expertise, experience, affiliations and interests relevant to the Chemicals Management Plan (CMP) Science Committee mandate, declared by committee members. Health Canada and Environment and Climate Change Canada considered these declarations as part of the appointment process.

This summary is available as part of Health Canada's commitment to be transparent about the membership of its advisory bodies.

#### Assessment of affiliations and interests prior to each meeting

Prior to each committee meeting, the advisory body Chair and Executive Secretary assess each member's affiliations and interests, including direct financial interests, as they may apply to agenda items. Based on this review, they will decide, if necessary, to limit a member's participation in all or part of the meeting agenda, and will inform the member of this decision. As well, on receipt of the meeting agenda, members are expected to review their own affiliations and interests against agenda items and advise the Chair and Secretariat if they see a potential cause for concern regarding the integrity and objectivity of their participation.

Members are expected to report promptly any changes in their circumstances as reported on the [Affiliations and Interests Declaration Form](#) to the Secretariat and the Chair of the advisory body. Health Canada also asks members to review their affiliations and interests declaration on an annual basis.

In accordance with sections 3.2 to 3.6 of the [Health Canada Policy on External Advisory Bodies](#), a person with a direct financial interest in a matter on the advisory body agenda may not participate in discussions with respect to that item, but they may participate in discussions regarding policy, management, or program development as they relate to the mandate of the advisory body.

#### Indicated Expertise/Experience

Significant and/or recent expertise (in other words, that which is acquired over a period of five years or more and/or within the last three years) is required in one or more of the following areas, including, but not limited to:

- A) Disciplines related to human health and/or ecological risk assessment (for example, toxicology and/or ecotoxicology, chemistry, biostatistics, bioinformatics, cheminformatics, exposure assessment)

- B) Predictive models and tools (for example, Quantitative Structure-Activity Relationships (QSAR), mass balance modelling, physiologically-based pharmacokinetic modelling, use of analogues, environmental fate and exposure)
- C) Emerging technologies (for example, nanotechnology, biotechnology, green chemistry)
- D) New approach methodologies (for example, high-throughput screening, high-content methods, Adverse Outcome Pathways, in vitro and in chemico assays, in silico approaches, Integrated Approaches to Testing and Assessment, data science/bioinformatics)
- E) Legislative and regulatory frameworks related to chemicals management in Canada and other jurisdictions
- F) Manufacture of chemicals and/or use of chemicals in product development in Canada and/or internationally (for example, lifecycle of products/manufactured items, chemical management practices)
- G) Application of weight of evidence and precaution in science-based decision making
- H) Sustainability (for example, responsible replacement practices)

### 1. Direct financial interests

- a) Do you, your spouse/partner, or dependent minor child have any direct financial interests that are of relevance to the mandate of the advisory body, including current employment, investments in companies, partnerships, equity, royalties, joint ventures, trusts, real property, stocks, shares, or bonds?

- b) Within the past five years, have you or your spouse/partner received materials, discounted products, gifts, or other benefits, or attended conferences or meetings where all or part of the travel and accommodation costs were provided by a party that has an interest in the mandate of the advisory body?<sup>2</sup>
- c) Within the past five years, have any of the organizations where you or your spouse/partner are currently employed or where you or your spouse/partner participate in internal decision making (that is, as a board member or as an executive or non-executive director) received grants or other funding from a party that has an interest in the mandate of the advisory body?<sup>3</sup>
